Agenda Item 1 – Welcome and Introductions

Sarah Brooks, Project Director, called the meeting to order, conducted a roll call, gave an overview of the seventh Committee meeting, walked through the agenda, meeting materials, and Committee timeline. Janel Myers, Quality SME, reviewed housekeeping notes for Committee members and members of the public.

Agenda Item 2 – Review of July 13, 2022 Meeting Summary (Transcript, P. 12)

Agenda Item 3 – Regulation and Enforcement Process

Agenda Item 4 – Benchmarking

Ms. Brooks gave an overview of the materials for the benchmarking discussion, provided a recap of the July meeting, shared definitions, and reviewed the voting process. Dr. Andy Baskin, Quality SME, MD, and Ignatius Bau, Health Equity SME reviewed examples and strengths and challenges for each of the benchmarking options under the Committee's review. For all the recommended measures, the Committee recommends using annually adjusted Quality Compass®¹ 25th or 50th percentile national Medicaid data for all health plans (regardless of line of business). The Committee had an evenly split vote on recommending either the 25th or 50th percentile as the benchmark.

Agenda Item 6 – Measure Stratification

(Transcript, P. 32-68)

Mr. Bau gave an overview of measure stratification, NCQA stratification categories, and federal standards. For measure stratification, the Committee recommends that, in addition to the eight HEDIS measures that already require stratification by race and ethnicity, the remaining five measures also be stratified by race and ethnicity using the NCQA race and ethnicity methodology. Further, as additional demographic data become available, the Committee recommends stratification be required on additional demographic points.
