SUPERSEDING ORDER EXEMPTING AND WAIVING GLOBAL RISK CONTRACT

Pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 1343(b), the Director of the Department of Managed Health Care (DMHC) finds the Entity's Request for Expedited Exemption, is in the public interest and not detrimental to the protection of subscribers, enrollees or persons regulated under the Knox-Keene Health Care Service Plan Act of 1975, as amended, (Health and Safety Code section 1340, *et seq.*) (the Act) and regulation of the persons or plan contracts is not essential to the purpose of the Act at this time. The Entity's originally approved Request for Expedited Exemption is extended through the effective date of the amendments to California Code of Regulations title 28, section 1300.49.

Pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 1343(b), the Director exempts Entity's contract from the requirements of Health and Safety Code section 1349. Pursuant to Health and Safety Code section 1344(a), the Director waives the requirements of California Code of Regulations title 28, section 1300.49(b)(2)(A) through (G).

This Order shall be in force and effect commencing on the date below, and remain in force and effect through the effective date of the amendments to California Code of Regulations title 28, section 1300.49, unless revoked or superseded by further Order of the Director.
